Yukon Aboriginal Sport Circle is seeking sport volunteers as coaches for the North American Indigenous Games in Halifax, Nova Scotia from July 15th-23rd, 2022. YASC is the Provincial Aboriginal Sport Governing Body that oversees the operations of Team Yukon, which will be comprised of 130 athletes, coaches, mission staff, chaperones and staff.

In conjunction with the Chef de Mission and Mission Staff coaching staff are required to oversee the participation, supervision and guidance of your athletes. As staff you are required to abide Team Yukon's policies and procedures, the code of conduct, rules and regulations of the North American Indigenous Games Host Society and Council.

GENERAL ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

PRE-GAMES

- Assist with team development such as athlete identification, tryouts, qualifying events, uniform allocation, and athlete registration
- Provide on-going athlete training and monitoring from selection to competition
- Attend a coach meeting late October 2022
- Provide a detailed plan for try-outs no later than November 2022
- Promote a safe, harassment free environment where athletes are treated with respect
- Attend all Team Yukon functions and ceremonies
- Organize and assist athletes with possible fundraising efforts (if needed)

GAMES TIME

- Mentorship and supervision of athletes
- Ensure athletes are aware of Team Yukon Code of Conduct
- Reside in athlete accommodations
- Coach in a fair and sportsmanlike manner
- Report all incidents to mission staff
- Travel with Team Yukon to and from Whitehorse, assisting Mission Staff with travel/ accommodation and accreditation.

POST-GAMES

- Provide a written evaluation of Team Yukon (an outline will be provided)
- Return any equipment and/or uniforms to the Chef de Mission

CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the sport specific requirements in the Sport Technical Package coaches must have the following courses or receive them no later than June 2023. If selected a Vulnerable Sector Check will be required! *
